The 80-minute documentary „I WON'T GO QUIETLY“ by filmmaker Anne Sono is a portrait of six women from four countries, whose stories are shocking and almost unbelievable. Anne Sono managed to highlight the emotional side to HIV/AIDS as well as its factual background. A brave portrait that encourages us to rethink everything we previously took as fact. Critical voices keep growing louder as scandalous news about made-up sicknesses, useless or even dangerous medications and lethal side-effects are making the round. Could it be that AIDS may be another one of those scandals?

Luckily, Nobel Prize-winning biochemist Kary Mullis is no longer the only one speaking the truth. Honest and accurate scientists have unmasked AIDS long ago for being nothing but a mere lucrative lie!

To this day, no single proof for the alleged existence of the so-called AIDS-Virus has been presented. Another interesting fact is that the so-called “AIDS-tests” already came out long before the abbreviation “AIDS” came to exist in correlation with its meaning today. Furthermore, the side-effects of the medication cannot be distinguished from the symptoms attributed to the sickness itself.

The HIV-antibody tests are not only worthless but dangerous, as they have no validity. Pregnant women and people with ordinary infections such as the flu receive a deadly diagnosis by means of these tests. An entire 60 different sicknesses can cause the HIV-tests to produce positive results. The exact testing methods and their interpretation differ from country to country, resulting in a person that got tested positive in England to possibly test negative in i.e. Greece or New Zealand.

James Shikwaiti, Kenyan libertarian economist and Director of the Inter Region Economic Network, said in an interview in 2005: "AIDS is big business, maybe Africa's biggest business. There's nothing else that can generate as much aid money as shocking figures on AIDS."

AIDS, the alleged "epidemic" and "most lethal of all diseases", officially accounts for less than 600 deaths per year, with allegedly 2000 newly acquired infections every year in Germany alone. Whilst these figures are being upheld and blown out of proportion, real sicknesses and devastating causes of death are swept under the carpet. In Germany, for example, EVERY YEAR 16.000 people die from medical malpractice, some 50.000 more due to insufficient hygiene in hospitals, 42.000 die from alcohol consumption, 74.000 die from the consumption of tobacco and no less than 130.000 people die from the consequences of being overweight.

However, no-one ever hears about these facts, whilst "AIDS" remains being upheld as the biggest health threat of our time. In other words: The alleged HI-virus kills less people per year than the doctor who diagnosed it.
